

HOW TO JOIN WASCA

There are two membership categories:

1. **Ordinary Membership** - available to
 - a) Individual persons who have been actively engaged in the daily management/organisation of a school canteen during the past five years;
 - b) Any school community which has responsibility for the operation of a school canteen, such school community being represented by one delegate
2. **Associate Membership** - available to:
 - a) Representatives of companies active in the provision of goods and services directly to school canteens.
 - b) Persons with an interest in the work of the Association.
 - c) Representatives of the WA Department of Education and WA Department of Health (no fees applicable)

OBJECTIVES OF WASCA

The Objectives of the Association are:

WHAT IT COSTS
