



Halloween in the canteen

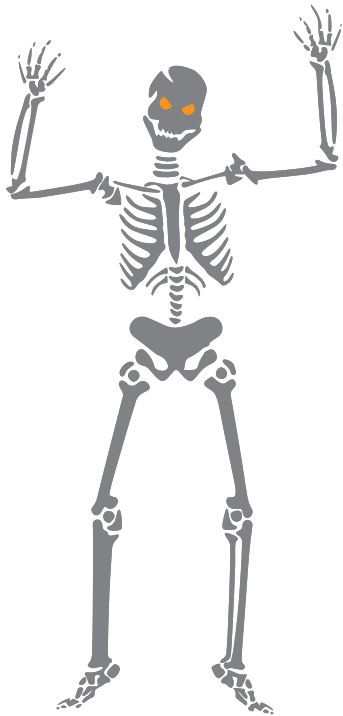
Halloween is so much more than trick or treat and it doesn't have to cost a fortune for the canteen to get involved.
