Canteens must ensure that the food prepared in the canteen is safe. Compliance with the Healthy Food and Drink policy requires canteen staff and volunteers to complete FoodSafe® Food Handler training (or equivalent). This session includes:

- Food handling & storage
- Cleaning procedures
- Temperature control
- Contamination
- Pest control
- Record keeping
- Allergy & cross contamination

Financial Management workshop

Running a canteen is equivalent to running a small business. At this session you will learn all about:

- Correctly calculating pricing for menu items
- Standardisation, portion control and waste minimisation
- Marketing and promotion techniques
- Record keeping and stock control.

Who should attend?

Canteen staff and volunteers who work in a secondary school canteen as well as parent body representatives responsible for operating the canteen.
